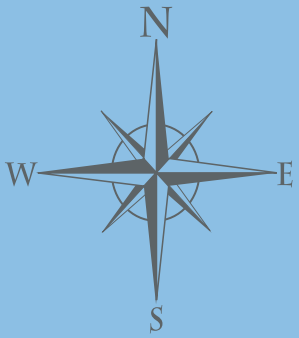

Directions from I-5 Freeway

From North Orange County and/or the Los Angeles area, take I-5 South and exit PCH North. When you exit, take a left at the second signal, Dana Point Harbor Drive. If you are coming from the south, exit at Beach Cities and follow the same directions. Parking is plentiful.

Parking and FREE Shuttle Information

The free shuttle runs each day from 10 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and services all parking lots and most event locations. Parking in the Harbor is FREE, but limited to four hours. Parking at Doheny State Park is \$15 for the entire day.

Parade Day Only (March 6)

FREE shuttle service will be available one hour prior to and at the conclusion of the Festival of Whales Parade. Park in the Harbor and ride to the northerly Parade Announcer Stand, the perfect location to view every entry in the parade. At the conclusion of the parade the shuttle will return you to the Ocean Institute shuttle stop. Stay on the shuttle if you wish to return to another location on the route.

5K and 1K Grunion Run Day Only (March 14)

FREE shuttle service will begin at 7 a.m. with pick ups at the Ocean Institute, OC Sailing & Event Center and at Golden Lantern/Dana Point Harbor Drive. Drops off directly at Doheny State Beach for the Grunion Run event. This shuttle will not service any other locations. Regular shuttle service will resume beginning at 10 a.m.
